Loneliness and AI

Obesity, opioids, and alcoholism are lifestyle diseases of national concern. The U.S. Surgeon General, Dr. Vivek Murthy, has added loneliness and isolation to the list of urgent public health concerns. "Loneliness is more than just a bad feeling," says Dr. Murthy. "When people are socially disconnected, their risk of anxiety and depression increases. So does their risk of heart disease (29 percent), dementia (50 percent), and stroke (32 percent)." Dr. Murthy believes we must "prioritize connection and healthy relationships." (Source: *Bioedge*, 5-30-23)

Oddly, writes attorney Jeff Childers, "a smartphone app called Replika has been in dozens of seemingly unrelated stories in the past few weeks." Replika is an AI "friend" or "companion." The history of this "chatbot" goes back to 2015 when Roman Mazurenko, the best friend of software developer Eugenia Kuyda, was killed in a car accident. Childers explains that "the grieving developer [Eugenia] gave her team hundreds of Roman's text messages and asked them to use the messages to train a private chatbot called Roman, named after her dead boyfriend. That experience led to the development of a commercial chatbot—which now includes augmented reality features—to solve a problem that Eugenia would later dub a 'pandemic of loneliness'. . . . According to Reuters, the company is solving about \$25 million a year's worth of loneliness, expressed in revenue from lonely users who are paying for bonus features like voice chats, so they can have fake heart-to-heart phone calls with the AI."

Not everyone is a fan of Replika. "In February," explains Childers, "Italy banned Replika from using personal data of users, which essentially banned the app itself, which can't work without collecting tons of personal data. Italy's Data Protection Agency cited

'risks to minors and emotionally fragile people,' according to a Reuters story." Defend Digital Me, a children's privacy advocacy group, told Reuters that "tools designed to influence a child's mood or mental well-being ought to be classified as medical products, and be subject to stringent safety standards." As a lawyer, Childers says, "I would strongly urge caution with using an application like Replika. The app is designed to tempt users into disclosing highly personal, if not outright confidential information. All that information . . . everything a user tells the chatbot, is being saved somewhere, and is therefore available for legal discovery. . . . perfectly innocent emails and text messages are often taken out of context by bad actors and used against the drafters " (Source: Coffee & Covid, Substack of Jeff Childers, 5-23-23)

What can we do? Be "the church" (Hebrews 10:23-25). Bring lonely people into the church family. Look for opportunities to spend time with a younger or older person who appears to be lonely. Serve as a reminder to lonely people that God loves us in this way: That He would send His only Son to die for us. Be confident that we have much to offer lonely people when we draw upon the promises of God: Deuteronomy 31:6; Psalm 25:16; Psalm 68:5-6; and Hebrews 13:5; 1 John 3:1a. Connect with lonely people through cards, letters, and texts. We need not be intimidated by the world into silence.

A Biomedical Security State Diminishes Humanity

The Body of Christ is hated because it is "the covenant community in and through which God Himself is at work remaking man in His own image and preparing him for glory." We can we do? As a member of the Body of Christ—the Church, give thanks to God! Chapters in the book include: "The Evolution of You," "Medical Powers, "Cosmetic Procedures," "Smart and Stupid Drugs," "Genetic Modification," "Clones," "Aging and Death," "Nanotechnology," "Bioprinting," "Cyborg Enhancements," "Uploading," "Robotics," "AI," and "Post-human Species."

What can we do? Never forget Genesis 3:1-5. Take note that Satan (who knows God's order of creation) ignored Adam and, instead, flattered Eve with his attention. Note that he didn't instruct Eve, but simply asked a question. Then, consider how Satan casts doubt on the relationship between God and Eve by suggesting that the Creator might be withholding knowledge and power from the created.
